Event brief (500 words with photo):

NSS unit of Jansons Institute of Technology functions actively to render credible service to the society. In this regard, our NSS unit team stride into the special camp at Elachipalayam Village, Somanur Panchayat, which is 5 kms away from our college. The theme of the camp was “Youth for Sustainable Development”. About 50 volunteers participated in the camp. During this 8 day camp the following activities were carried out.

12.03.2016, Saturday

The team with 50 members reached the village at 10.00 am to make necessary arrangements for the camp. NSS Programme officer Mr. K. Senthamil Selvan briefed about the survey activities. Then the volunteers were grouped to carry out a survey about the village and various committees were formed for the smooth conduct of the camp.

The camp was inaugurated at 2 PM with the NSS song. Dr. V. Nagarajan, Principal, JIT gave the presidential address and Mrs. N. Santhanalakshmi, HM, Panchayat Union Middle School, gave the felicitation address and assured to extend support for our activities.

13.03.2016, Sunday

At 9 AM, the NSS volunteers arrived and started reading news paper and which was followed by a discussion on different topics. The NSS volunteers started their field work at Chenniyandavar Temple. They cleaned the temple premises. The entire day was utilized to clean in and around the temple.



At 6 PM, cultural events were conducted to motivate the volunteers and Elachipalayam village people. An **“Awareness on saving schemes for poor people”** was organized by our students for the villagers explaining the advantages of the saving schemes.

14.03.2016, Monday

During the morning session, the volunteers were participated in cleaning the Panchayat Union Middle School, Elachipalayam. An awareness on **“Women Empowerment”** in the village was carried out accelerating Progress towards the Economic Empowerment of Rural Women.

At 2 PM, an inspirational talk was given on “Drugs and its effects” by Mr. K. Murali, IV EEE and Mrs. S. Lakshmi gave the felicitation address. At 6 PM, the NSS volunteers conducted Awareness Programme for the villagers.

15.03.2016, Tuesday

On the fourth day, the NSS volunteers were divided into five groups and each group was allocated a particular area to clean.

At 9 AM, sports competitions were conducted for the school children by NSS Volunteers in the presence of the school teacher Mrs. A. Anandhi. They eagerly participated and enjoyed the games.

At 2 PM, JIT EEE department students Mr. Praveen Kumar and Ms. Subhathi, made a presentation on **“Electricity Management”** to raise awareness on less consumption of energy and tangible benefits achieved by using more efficient technologies and Awareness on **“Girl Child Security”** to teach the girl children of the school to be aware of their surroundings and notable signs to look out. At the end of this day, Awareness on gender issue-Street Drama for the villagers was enacted.

16.03.2016, Wednesday

At 9 AM, the NSS volunteers arrived and started reading the newspaper and had a healthy discussion on different topics.

At 10 AM, the NSS volunteers started the Dengue and Ziga Virus Awareness campaign in Elachipalayam Village and the volunteers personally spoke to the villagers and created awareness about the causes, effects and control measures of the diseases. The campaign was headed by the school teacher Mrs. U. Ralin Leena.

At 2 PM, the students of JIT Tamil Mandram conducted Debate on the Topic “Role of youths in Environmental Conservation”. The programme was headed by the school teacher Mrs. A. Saleth Marry.

At 3 PM, “Talent Identification Programme” was conducted by NSS Volunteers and they



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organized various events such as essay writing, poem writing, speech competitions and drawing competitions. The school children effectively participated in the programme and exhibited their skills. The day came to close with the cultural events.

17.03.2016, Thursday

The NSS volunteers arrived at 9 AM and the programme began by reading the news paper, followed by which was a healthy discussion on various topics.
