Event brief (500 words with photo): National Girl Child Day was celebrated through online mode for the faculty and student members of Jansons Institute of Technology. The third session of the webinar was from 11.00 to 12.00 a.m. on "Guaranteeing Equal Access of Women to Society" . The presenter for this session was Ms. Rita Poorani , Assistant Professor, Bhaktavachalam Memorial College for Women, Chennai. The speaker initiated her talk by saying that only gender equality would build a nation and a society attains better development in all aspects only when both genders are entitled to similar opportunities. Gender stereotyping has been highlighted as one of the significant barriers for women's equal access to justice. In the context of women's access to justice, gender stereotyping plays an important role, in particular those stereotypes that primarily consider men as bearers of rights, authority and knowledge. Belonging to vulnerable groups of women can result in an increased restriction of access to certain rights, including justice. Speaker highlighted that Women living in rural areas, elderly women, women with disabilities, lesbian/bisexual/ transgender women, trafficked women, migrants and women from certain social, ethnic or religious groups are structurally disadvantaged. This may be due to specific disadvantages at the socio-economic level, but can also be the result of a lack of awareness of their specific needs among justice or law-enforcement officials. The event had a happy ending with the vote of thanks by Yehasary of IAI.	
Outcomes	The participants' grasped knowledge that only gender equality would build a nation and a society attains better development in all aspects only when both genders are entitled to similar opportunities.

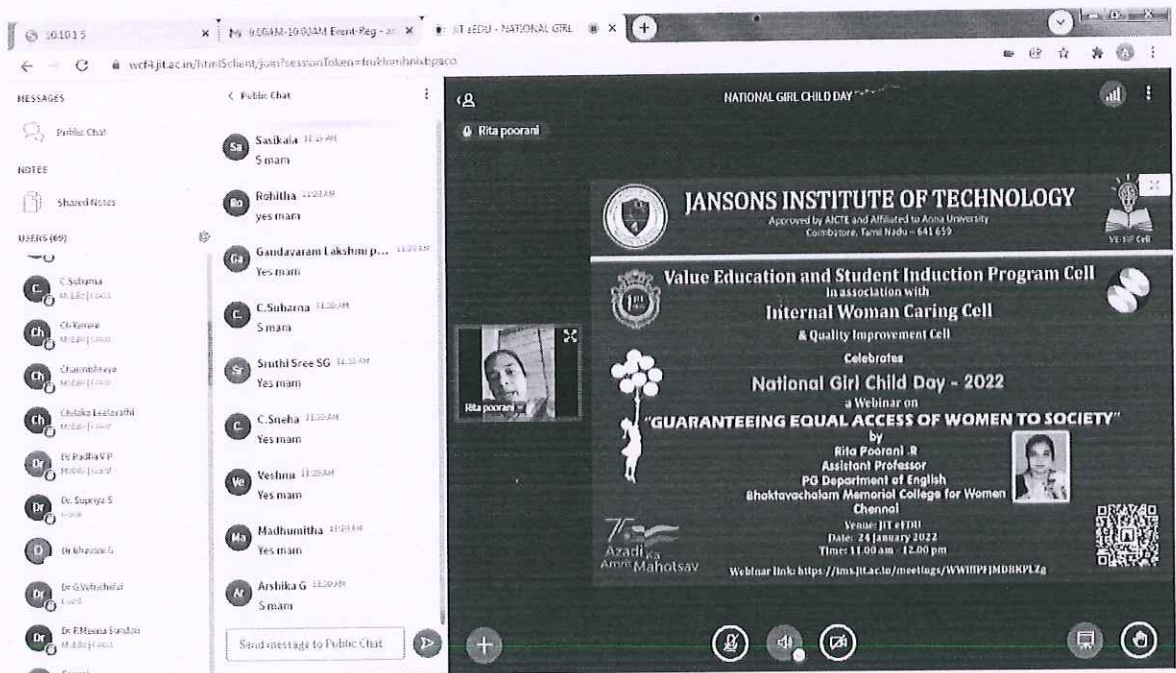
