


With reference to the above, it may be noted that some of clauses in Regulations 2017 have been amended.

1. Amendments in the Regulations of R-2017 for Non-Autonomous Colleges Affiliated to Anna University.

i. Applicable to all B.E. / B.Tech. Programmes offered under R-2017.
