Event Objective

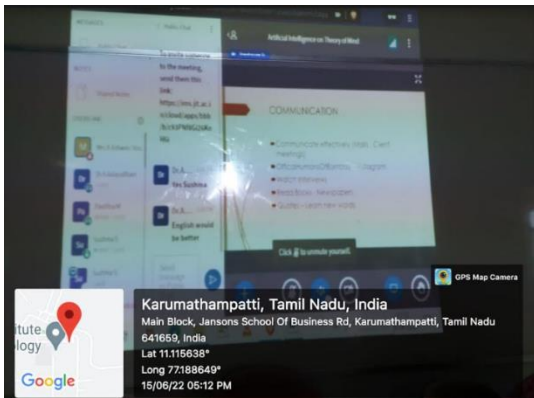

Event Summary

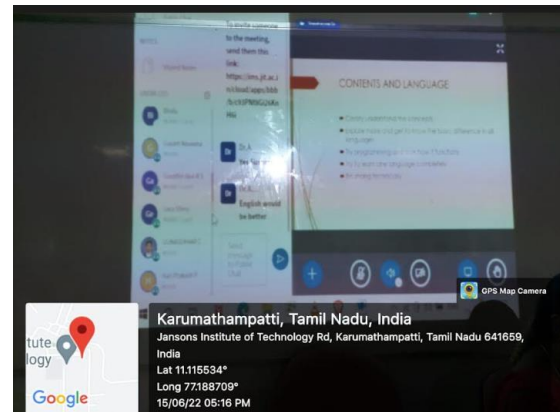

understand it better.

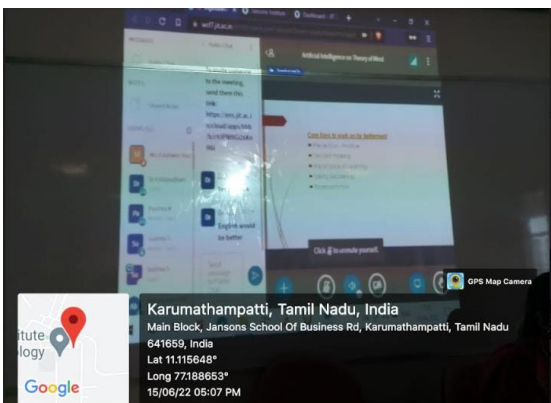
