



Anti-Ragging Committee - Annual Report (2019-2020)

An UGC regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 had been published in the Gazette of India dated 4th July 2009 and is available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. To implement the recommendations and to prevent ragging, an Anti-Ragging Committee and squad had been formed to address the issues concerning ragging. Anti -Ragging Committee and squad had been constituted in this institution to prevent ragging and to take Anti-Ragging measures as per the guide lines issued by the Supreme Court of India & UGC.

Under the pretext of 'welcoming' new students to the college, ragging is a practice that gives senior students an excuse to harass their junior counterparts and make them easy targets to satiate their own pleasures. The students of the institution had been educated that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging they are liable for the below mentioned punishments.

Administrative action in the event of ragging:


Depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, to be awarded,

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
3. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
4. Withholding results.
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
6. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
7. Cancellation of admission.
8. Rustication from the institution.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
10. Prosecuted for criminal action.

The freshers / junior students had been advised that they should not respond to the calls from seniors, should not participate in any kind of party anywhere inside/outside the campus, even if ordered by the seniors and that, they have nothing to fear as the institution cares for them and shall not tolerate any atrocities against them. Two discussions by the Anti-Ragging committee had been conducted for the academic year 2019-2020 on 1.7.2019 and 2.1.2020 and continuous follow-up is in progress.

Awareness of Anti-Ragging committee and squad & its activities had been provided to the newly joined students during their orientation program. An awareness program for first years had been provided by Heads of Departments, stressing on the importance of Anti-Ragging and the severity of punishments that shall be awarded in case proved to have indulged in such guilt. The

students had been made aware and clearly educated about the anti-ragging rules. Awareness among the students regarding the **Toll Free Anti Ragging Helpline number, 1800-180-5522** had also been established. More than 100 students had participated in the awareness program and a pledge had been taken by the students that they won't indulge in ragging.



Students and parents had given undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging activities while joining the Institute. Anti-ragging Banners, Posters/Slogans had been put up in and around the institute area like notice board, departments, corridors, canteen, library and hostels etc. to generate awareness amongst students. Also CCTV cameras are present at all vital points of the institute. Awareness had been created among first year Students and Parents about anti-ragging by getting the affidavits from the students and their parents/guardians.

Surprise visits had been taken by committee members. Roster duty had been provided to the squad members periodically at different places in and around the campus and in the hostel. Anti-Ragging committee and squad members' names and contact details had been displayed in the college website and notice boards. Vigilance rounds had been taken by all Anti ragging committee and squad members on rotation basis. Surprise visits had been made to reassure that no sort of

ragging activities exist in the campus corridors, canteen, laboratories, hostels, bus bay etc. The students had also been monitored during interval, lunch break and after college hours while boarding the college transport facility.

JIT campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to ensure that the freshers are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors in the name of an obsolete, barbaric ritual. Regarding matter relating to complaint, there had been no such case before the committee showing that the college campus is free from ragging.

All of this was possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and teachers.

ANTI RAGGING UNDERTAKING (AFFIDAVIT) BY THE STUDENT

1. I hereby affirm that, if found guilty of ragging, I am liable for punishment according to clause 9.1 of the Regulations, without prejudice to any other criminal action that may be taken against me under any penal law or any law for the time being in force. I hereby declare that I have not been expelled or debarred from admission in any institution in the country on account of being found guilty of, abetting or being part of a conspiracy to promote, ragging; and further affirm that, in case the declaration is found to be untrue, I am aware that my admission is liable to be canceled.




