Event brief (500 words with photo):

Student Induction Programme (SIP) for the academic year 2021 – 22 was conducted from 80.11.2021 to 20.11.2021 for two weeks with enthusiasm and great vigor.

All the new entrants were greeted by the faculty members for their respective departments. The students were warmly welcomed by the respective Head of their departments and their class mentors. Students were given the information about various facilities available at the campus. Class mentors briefed about their roles and responsibilities, rules and regulations to be followed inside the campus.

In view of Centenary Celebrations of Students Induction program Dr. M.V.Suresh Kumar inaugurated the function on 8th November 2021 and he threw light on the importance of fundamental concepts in Engineering field. He also insisted how the students should prepare themselves for their future career. His lecture was followed by a talk from Dr.P.Meena Sundari, Professor / Chemistry on Academic System — Anna University, Chennai. Her talk highlighted various curricular and co-curricular aspects that has to be followed for the benefit of students.

Physical Activity:

Entire SIP was engaged with physical activity by involving the students in Sports, physical fitness, games, etc.

Creative Arts:

In order to make the students more creative and to bring out the inner creative talents students were regularly involved in fine arts activities like drawing, painting, pencil sketching and finally interested students were asked to submit their work to their mentors. Students exhibited their talents and creations and happily they were involved in the given activity.

Universal Human Values:

This is the anchoring activity of the Induction Programme. All the students were given login to access different modules of UHV in JITeEDU platform. They are assisted with the course materials and videos. Everyday a topic was discussed by the mentors during the class. At the end of each module they have to take up an assignment and on successful completion of the modules they received a certificate of appreciation.

Literary Activity:

To induce and inculcate literary knowledge among students, Dr.S.R.Parameswaran, AP, Department of English framed different modules to improve their proficiency in English. From day 5 to Day 11 he introduced and gave training in various topics like Diagnostic test, Personality Trait & Learning Style, E – Mail Etiquettes, Resume Building, Self-Introduction module I and module II, Group discussion and Public speaking skills. Participation of the students was 100% and they learnt the skills with enthusiasm.

Proficiency Modules & Department specific activities:

To overcome the lacunas in fundamental of science especially in the field of computer science a special program module called "Program Basics" was designed by the faculty members of Department of Computer Science. The PB module started with an Introduction to PB, PB – Variable, PB – Looping and Iteration, PB Sections, PB Summary and completion. The fundamentals of programming were taught to the students by the faculty members which gave them a confidence in computer basics. The knowledge given will be useful to the students in learning Python programming and similar languages in computers.

Motivational lectures:

Motivational lectures by eminent people from all walks of life were arranged to give the students an exposure to people who are socially active or in public life.

Professor of Physics, Dr.D.Geethalakshmi educated the students on "Values and Eth

Mr. M. Arun Prashanth, Quality Controller Engineer, Mitsui Hi Tec, Canada gave an inspiring online speech on "Successful Engineer". He shared many success stories which he got inspiration and also shared his views to become a successful engineer.

Mrs. S.Alagulakshmi, Electrical Design Engineer, Siemens Technology, Coimbatore our proud alumni threw light on "Campus to Corporate – Transform yourself". She narrated and ignited the young students with her thoughtful speech. She also shared her own experience in industry.

Mr. S. Karthikeyan, Senior Manager – Projects, CTS Corp, Raleigh, NC, USA spoke on various opportunities which are open for engineers abroad and also in India. The session was online and was very much interactive. He guided the students and clarified their doubts regarding job openings abroad and how to prepare themselves for it.

A webinar on "Awareness on GATE Exam" was delivered online to the students by Mr.Sathyamoorthy V & Mr.R.Vivekanandhan, Unacademy, Chennai. They conducted a quiz and announced prize to the winners during the program. Many students enquired about the methods to prepare for competitive exams and other higher studies related exams.

All the lectures were very mush inspiring and they kindled the engineering mind inside each student.

Familiarization to Dept./Branch & Innovations:

Heads of various departments gave an introduction to Professional Societies, Technical Clubs and Creative Clubs in the institute as a whole and clubs confined to respective departments. Dr.B.Senthilnathan, Professor / Maths gave an Introduction to Value added Courses and Industry

In between the SIP we also organized Alumni talk. Freshers interacted with their seniors and gathered some knowledge on their field and opportunities ahead.








INTRODUCTION OF TECHNICAL AND NON-TECHNICAL CLUBS




